

# MOODLE FOR TRANSITION YEAR

## LOG IN

To access LOETB's Moodle site, go to <https://loetb.etbonline.ie>

Click the red "Log in" button the top right corner and enter the username and password you were given (username is usually your firstname and lastname, with no spaces, though it may differ slightly from this if another learner has the same name).

The first time you log in, you will be asked to change your password and to accept a site policy.

If you forget your password or username, you can use the "Forgotten your username or password?" link and you will get an email with a link to reset the password.

## HOME PAGE

When you log in you will be brought to your home page where you will find the course tile(s) for the course(s) you are enrolled on (see below). Click on a tile to access the course content.



On the top right corner you will see a drop down arrow beside you name, you can edit your profile here.

On the right hand side is the "blocks" area (Navigation block is visible above). Just above the blocks you have the option to show or hide the blocks



You also have a ribbon with "Home" button etc that you can use to move around Moodle.

## YOUR COURSE(S)

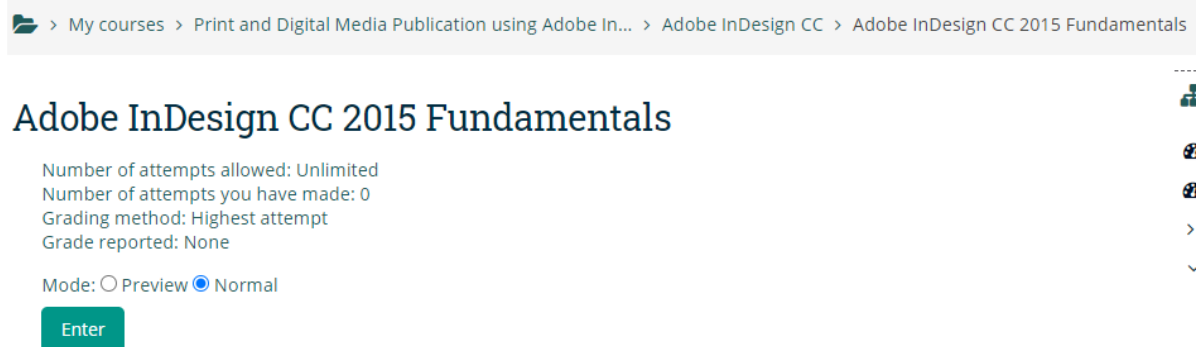
The course layout may vary from one course to another but generally follows the same pattern. Some courses are completely self-contained and you will do all exercises etc within the one screen, while others will give you instruction but you will have to switch to the relevant software to carry out the actual tasks.

Click on the course tile and you'll see the topics for that course (sample below)

Click on the first topic and you will be brought to a screen like the one below



(Note the navigation bar here, where you can jump to different sections, go back to your course list etc.)

It may take a moment to load, but you will then see a course outline which will give you more details on this topic, what you will learn, approximately how long it should take, is it for beginners, etc.

When you are ready, click “Start Course”

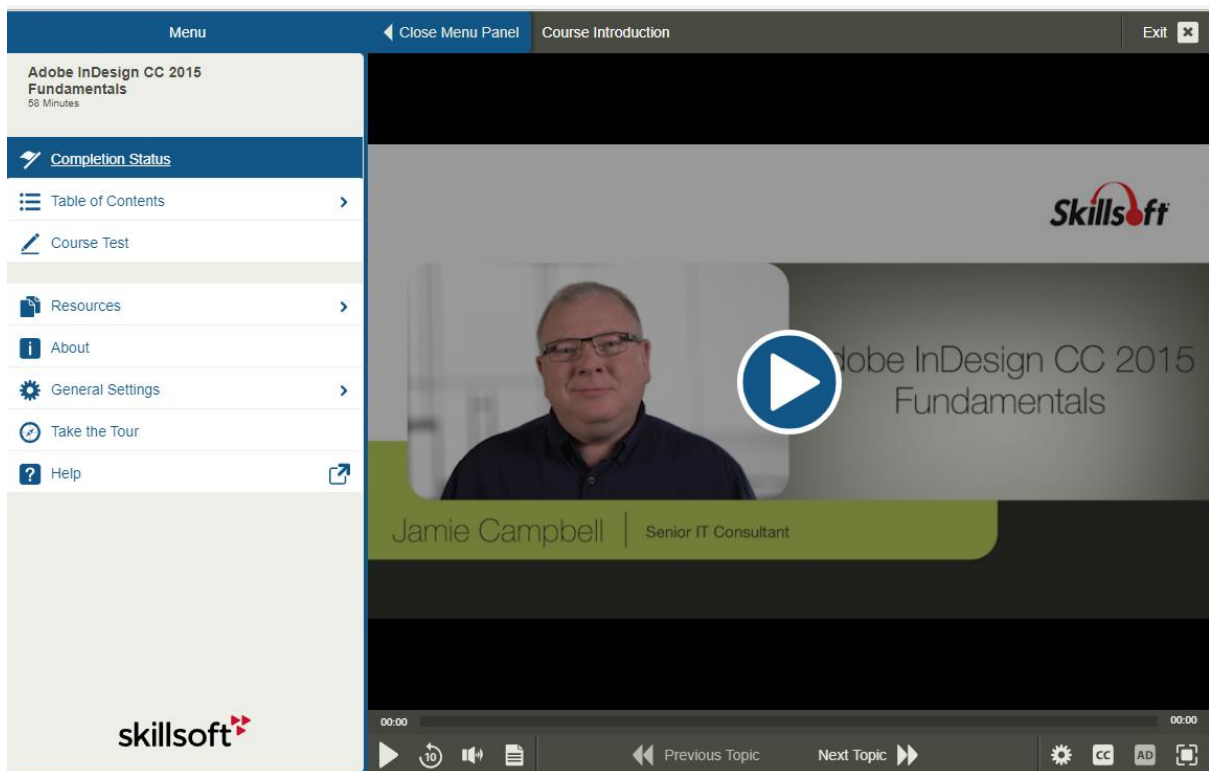
