Examples of Learning Disabilities and Learning Difficulties

- ADHD/ADD
- Blind or Visually Impaired
- Autism/ASD
- Deaf or Hard of Hearing
- Dyslexia
- Dyscalculia
- Dyspraxia/DCD
- General Learning Difficulty (GLD)
- Neurological conditions, such as Epilepsy or brain injury
- Physical Disability, such as Cerebral Palsy
- Physical mobility, such as Wheelchair users
- Speech and Language communication disorders

Examples of chronic or significant ongoing illness

- Cystic Fibrosis
- Diabetes
- Gastroenterological conditions, such as Crohn's Disease
- Epilepsy
- Asthma
- Arthritis
- Heart condition

Examples Mental health conditions

- Bipolar disorder
- Clinical depression
- Obsessive compulsive disorder
- Psychosis
- Schizophrenia
- Severe anxiety
- Severe phobias
- Severe eating disorders

Note: you may be asked to provide a report on your condition or disability from a professional, such as a Medical Consultant, Psychiatrist, Psychologist, Occupational Therapist, Paediatrician, or Speech and Language Therapist.
